

Attention all competitors,

Majestic Farm is recommending a NEW protocol due to the EHV and Strangles outbreaks that are currently occurring in northern Ohio. While we still only require competitors to submit current negative Coggins and a vaccine record for each horse, it is strongly recommended that each individual competitor perform a few simple checks to ensure the safety of both their horse and the other horses present on our show grounds.

- Monitor for fevers exceeding 101.5 degrees.
- Avoid nose to nose contact between horses.
- Receive routine vet care and vaccinations.

At Majestic Farm, to ensure optimal safety for all horses and competitors attending, we will have a minimum of ONE stall spacing between barn groups attending our shows.

If your horse is showing any symptoms of illness or has been confirmed positive for any disease within 30 days of the competition, please do not attend.

As a premier boarding and show facility, our top priority is keeping all horses safe and free of disease.
